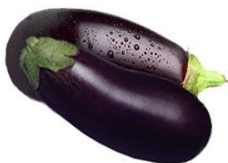
Market Report

Avocado: Strong demand continues to drive the market. California harvest is starting to outpace Mexican harvests.
Bell Peppers: Green bell market is relatively steady. Colored bells are starting to settle.
Berries: Strawberry market continues to be strong going into Memorial Day. Other berry markets are relatively steady.
Broccoli / Cauliflower: Broccoli & cauliflower markets are steady to start the week; however, demand is expected to pick up.
Celery: Supplies are becoming steady again. Oxnard is the main growing region.
Citrus: Lemons out of Ventura are in full production, with strong demand continuing, especially on smaller sizes. Navel orange production is light, especially on smaller sizes. Lime supplies are good.
Grapes: Grape Market is improving overall from last week.
Lettuce: Leaf market is relatively steady. Iceberg lettuce is active due to lower yields.
Melons: Melon market is improving. Mexican melons are crossing into Nogales and CA melons are slow to come on.
Squash: Markets on yellow squash & zucchini are active.
Tomatoes: Market is up a bit overall with supplies lessening out of the growing regions.
